Collaboration

The Agency will support staff in building relationships with school and organization partners. The Agency will develop transparent communication between leadership and onsite staff. Leadership will empower onsite staff and rely on them as experts on the site and partners. The Agency is committed to developing more trust throughout the agency and providing more opportunities for cross-program collaboration and training.

Integrity

The Agency is committed to transparency between leadership and staff. Opportunities for leadership will be accessible and prioritized within the agency and staff will be supported in their growth. Peer input will be encouraged and are empowered to provide their input to agency leaders.

Financial Responsibility

The Agency will be transparent in agency financials. Leadership will share the budget and audit process with staff. Staff will be included in the budgeting process and agency financials will be discussed through an equity lens.
